Welcome to the Lydney Town Band organisation. We are a friendly band and hope that you will enjoy yourself either learning with us or taking part in our band performances. We have a strong commitment to developing new brass players, with a dedicated learning programme. This involves running a separate Starter Group and Training Band, which will help our Town Band to move forward.

Band Ethos

Our main aim is to perform at a good standard, whilst supporting our members and enjoying our music making in the local and wider community. In the Town Band we expect a level of commitment to rehearsals, maintaining a good standard of performance, participation in competitions and concert performances and always representing the band professionally. Rehearsals are on Friday evenings at the Band Room GL15 5RU 7.30-9.30pm.

Two members in the band are BandSafe trained, and all tutors have enhanced DBS in place.

Equipment

Town Band members need to supply their own uniform of white shirt, black trousers/skirt black socks and shoes to wear at engagements. We will supply a band jacket and tie with the Band logo, helping to promote pride in our Band. We may be able to provide you with an instrument, if needed, or you can play your own. If you borrow an instrument, you are responsible for looking after it and keeping it safe and clean. Your instrument will be insured while you are using it in the band room or on a band job. You will need to insure it at your own home. The instrument and any other band property will need to be returned in good working order if you decide to no longer play with the band.

Fund-raising

Fund-raising events are also organised to raise money for music, instruments, and uniforms. There is a Monthly Prize Draw to join for just £1 a month with a monthly prize of £30 minimum. It is hoped that Band Members will join the Monthly Prize Draw. If you have ideas for fundraising, please speak to our Fundraising Officer. There is also an easyfundraising link where you can raise money for the band at no extra cost to yourself.

Health & Safety

The Band room is regularly assessed for risk and relevant changes made. There is a fire extinguisher in the main hall and a further one in the corridor. In the event of a fire members should muster in the car park outside of the band grounds.

Subscriptions

It is expected that Band members pay £1 a week subscription. This money will cover the band running costs relating to heating, lighting, building maintenance, insurances, music purchase and supporting our grass root players. The annual subscription cost is £50, which can be paid quarterly or annually if preferred. It only applies to members over 18 that are in full time employment. The Chairman has the discretion to waive subscriptions for members where appropriate. Subscriptions will be collected by standing order, however other arrangements can be made if preferred.






